

Dear Parents,

This year we are pleased to introduce online registration and payment for Religious Education students in grades Kindergarten-Confirmation. All registrations must be completed online as we are no longer offering mail-in registration or payment. Please [click here](#) for the link to the online form.

Class assignment is on a first-come, first-serve basis so please complete your registration promptly in order to ensure your preferred day. On the online form, drop-down menus will allow you to choose the appropriate program(s) for your child(ren), select class days, and to pay online. For your convenience you may use an online check or pay with a credit card. Total fees will be calculated online.

The fees for this year have not been increased and are as follows:

\* The Sacramental Fee for First Eucharist is in addition to the usual Religious Education program fee. The Sacramental Fee for Confirmation is the total cost for the program.

Families who are experiencing a financial hardship should complete and submit the online registration form without payment and then please contact the Religious Education office at 973-376-1960 to discuss any particular needs or payment plan options. With the assistance of our parents and many volunteers the Religious Education staff works tirelessly to fulfill the important calling of faith formation. Please assist us by:

- Reviewing all your personal information and ensuring the information is correct.

- Choosing a volunteer option on the registration form. We have a large program and rely on the help of adult volunteers to make it run smoothly. Each family is expected to volunteer a minimum of one hour per child per year. Thank you in advance for your parish community service and support.
- Considering being one of our catechists: We provide training and support throughout the year, background notes for each lesson, and will walk with you each step of the way. For those who are catechists, we offer a tuition reduction of the fee for one student.
- Considering the option of co-teaching with someone else; co-catechists receive a ½ tuition reduction of the fee for one student.
- Asking a high school student to consider being an aide to a catechist (Besides their own faith enrichment we will provide letters of recommendations for colleges.)

More specific details pertaining to Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade, First Eucharist Preparation, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade and Confirmation Preparation will be sent separately and will be available on our parish website.
