The St. John's Bible is the first illuminated, handwritten Bible to be commissioned by a Benedictine monastery in over 500 years. Designed to "ignite the spiritual imagination of people of all faiths," the Bible was produced by a team of theologians, artists, and calligraphers over a period of 15 years. While the massive seven-volume original may be viewed only in Collegeville, Minnesota (the home of its sponsors), Caldwell University is privileged to host one volume (Gospels and Acts) of the Heritage edition of the Bible throughout 2019. A series of lectures, programs, and events are planned for the year, and outside audiences are welcome and encouraged to participate. We are privileged to have Dr. Mullaney at St. Rose to introduce us to this magnificent work.
